Calming Collars

Beaphar Calming Collars are designed to reduce problem behaviour in cats and dogs. Like humans, dogs and cats have good and bad days, and on those not so good days they may perform unwanted behaviours around the home such as excessive barking and vertical scratching. Other dogs and cats simply do not enjoy those 'must do' activities such as visits to the vet, travelling by car and time spent in kennels and catteries.

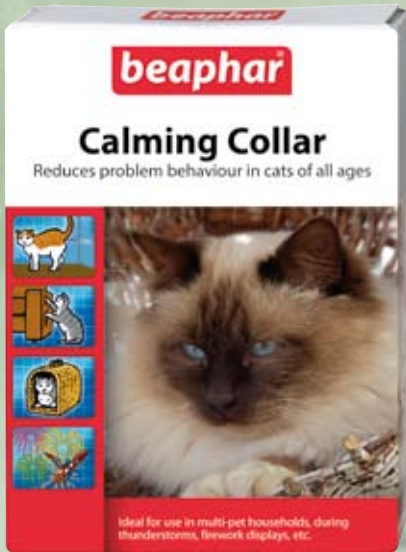
The Beaphar Calming Collar effectively reduces problem behaviour arising from stressful situations in dogs and cats. Over a period of 30 days, the collar releases a substance called a 'pheromone' which helps calm cats and dogs in a natural way, resulting in calmer, happier, more sociable pets. It is important to differentiate between an odour and a pheromone. Pheromones are natural signaling agents which have an effect on an animal's behaviour.

The word pheromone is a combination of two Greek words namely "pherein" (to carry) and "horman" (stimulate). Pheromones stimulate emotional centres in the brain, and in so doing can produce a change in behaviour. They play a natural and important part in animal communication.

Calming Collar - Cat



The Beaphar Calming Collar for cats of all breeds and ages contains a synthetic form of a pheromone produced by cats which makes them feel calm and secure in their own environment.

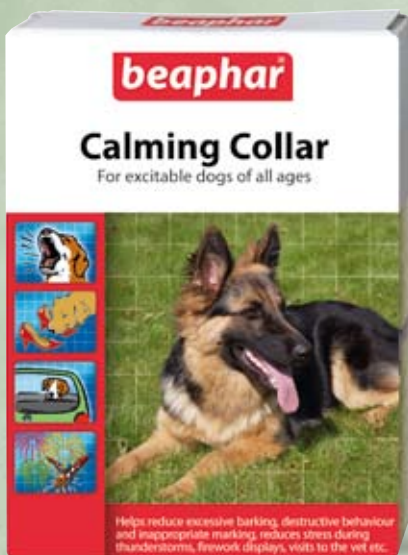
The Beaphar Calming Collar can help to keep cats calm in new, stressful, or scary situations like moving to a new home, during thunderstorms and firework displays, visits to the vet and living in multi-pet households, etc. It reduces excessive meowing, destructive behaviour, such as vertical scratching, and inappropriate marking, such as urine spraying.

The collar includes a safety mechanism to allow for release if the cat were to get into difficulty.

If the collar does not achieve the desired result, you may wish to consult your vet, as some behavioural problems have a clinical origin. In multi-cat households and with older cats, a continuous period of use of 45 days or more may be required.

Calming Collar - Dog



The Beaphar Calming Collar for dogs of all breeds and ages contains a synthetic form of a pheromone produced by mother dogs which has a calming effect on their puppies. However, it continues to have a calming effect throughout a dog's life, helping them feel less apprehensive with a resulting reduction in undesirable behaviours.

The Beaphar Calming Collar can help to keep dogs calm in new, stressful or scary situations such as going to a new home, travelling, during thunderstorms or firework displays, visits to the vet or kennels, when you have to leave him/her at home for a little while, etc. It reduces excessive barking, destructive behaviour and inappropriate marking.

In some dogs, undesirable behaviours have been "learned", and may require behavioural therapy to resolve the problem. If the collar has not achieved the desired effect after a period of 45 days continuous use, you should consult your vet or a dog behavioural consultant.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does the collar work?

When the collar is fitted, pheromones are released by means of the collar rubbing against the skin/fur. These are breathed in and are registered by a sensory organ at the back of the hard palate. A signal is sent to an emotional centre in the brain, resulting in a calming sensation in the dog or cat.

How long does the collar take to start working?

As soon as the collar has been fitted, pheromones will be released. The period of time before a change in behaviour is noticed will vary with individuals and the particular problem.

Can I use the collar at intervals?

Once the packaging has been opened, it is recommended to place the collar around the neck of the animal for one continuous period of 30 days. This will ensure the dog/cat receives pheromones steadily. If the collar is removed from the animal the pheromones will continue to be released. You can use the collar intermittently, but remember that the pheromone content will have declined when not in use.

How does the collar react to water?

It is recommended that the collar is removed before washing the dog/cat as it will not work when it is wet and shampoos can strip it of the pheromones. A short walk in the rain will be okay, as this will not be wet enough for long enough to affect the collar.

Can I use the collar together with other collars?

Other collars will not have an effect on the pheromone collar but it is important that the pheromone collar does not get covered up by any other collar. Covering up the pheromone collar will affect the release of the pheromones, thus reducing the positive influence on the animal.
